With a focus on sea turtles, her projects cover a wide range of issues, including nesting beach ecology, the impact of fisheries on sea turtle populations, and developing holistic conservation strategies in Africa, the Middle East, Asia, and the South Pacific. The local communities in the Turtle Islands of Sierra Leone have named a beach "Manjula Beach" in recognition of her efforts to conserve their sea turtles.
